

POHLAD FOUNDATION CAMP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION 2017

All scholarship requests are due to the PACT Office as soon as possible.

The Pohlad Family Foundation has made a limited number of funds available for children in the PACT for Families service area in need of financial assistance to attend a week-long residential summer camp. **The camp attended must be one approved by the foundation** (see website on next page) and follow these identified priorities: 1) only children from age 7 through age 16 can receive scholarships (*PACT for Families is targeting ages 11-15*); 2) a maximum of \$500 per child may be spent on camp tuition for 1st time campers and \$300 for second-time campers; 3) the majority of scholarships must be provided to youth who have never attended a residential summer camp. All requests submitted will be considered, with priority given to children who best meet the guidelines of the Pohlads Foundation. Because of the high number of requests expected, and the limited dollars available, priority will be given to children who have not been to camp before, have limited summer opportunities available to them, and could most benefit from such an experience. Camp scholarships available through this program are limited to \$500 per child (1st time campers) and \$300 for second-time campers. If camp tuition is more than the scholarship award, funds from other sources will need to be secured to make up the difference.

You will be notified as soon as possible if your child has been accepted to receive a scholarship. **Once accepted, you will need to select a camp and make the necessary arrangements directly with the camp. Communication with PACT is essential in order for the payment to be processed accordingly.** PACT for Families will send the camp registration fee directly to the camp after you have finalized the date. A letter will be sent to you with the information you will need to complete the registration process.
