Diversion Program for High Risk Youth

Participants, with the support of family, will make healthy personal decisions about chemical use. This program is directed at high risk youth who are first time offenders within the judicial system and/or youth experiencing problems in family life, school, work, or community which are associated with drug/alcohol abuse.

Domestic Abuse Program (Marshall Facility)

The Domestic Abuse Program is based upon the belief that violence is intentional. Battering is viewed as a system of behaviors which are used to maintain control and dominance in relationships with significant others. However, it is believed that individuals can change and that, except in cases of self-defense, there are always alternatives to violence.

Women's Program

Offers a safe, nurturing environment for the recovery process to begin; one where a woman can begin to explore her potential and regain feelings of self-worth and self-esteem.

Outpatient Program

To deal with an alcohol or other drug problem while continuing in their daily routine of work or school. Our professional counseling staff will assist you in restructuring your life and establishing a contented chemically free lifestyle through the use of education, group therapy, individual sessions, spiritual counseling and family involvement.

"Vanguard" Compulsive Gambling Treatment Program

Vanguard's staff includes a professional compulsive gambling counselor and two peer counselors. It is an abstinence-oriented program based on the 12-step philosophy of Gamblers Anonymous. Vanguard is designed to offer the help and hope necessary to make recovery and life-long abstinence form gambling a reality. The length of treatment varies for each individual.

Family Program

Sometimes individuals, couples and families feel the need to discuss issues related to alcohol and chemical dependency as well as codependency with a counselor in a private setting. Short-term therapy and appropriate referrals are available through Turnabout's Family Program.

Residential Programs

The chronic chemically dependent person needs time to get well, but it can happen, in fact, believing in change for the chronic user is the main ingredient of the Extended Care Program.

Halfway House

The focus of the program is to assist recovering men to integrate the tools they have acquired in primary treatment into their daily lives. Apartment management tasks such as cooking, shopping and cleaning allow reintroduction to the importance of self-care, time-management, and adjustment to the demands of a lifestyle of recovery.
